Students are expected to follow the dress code while in LaunchED@Home.

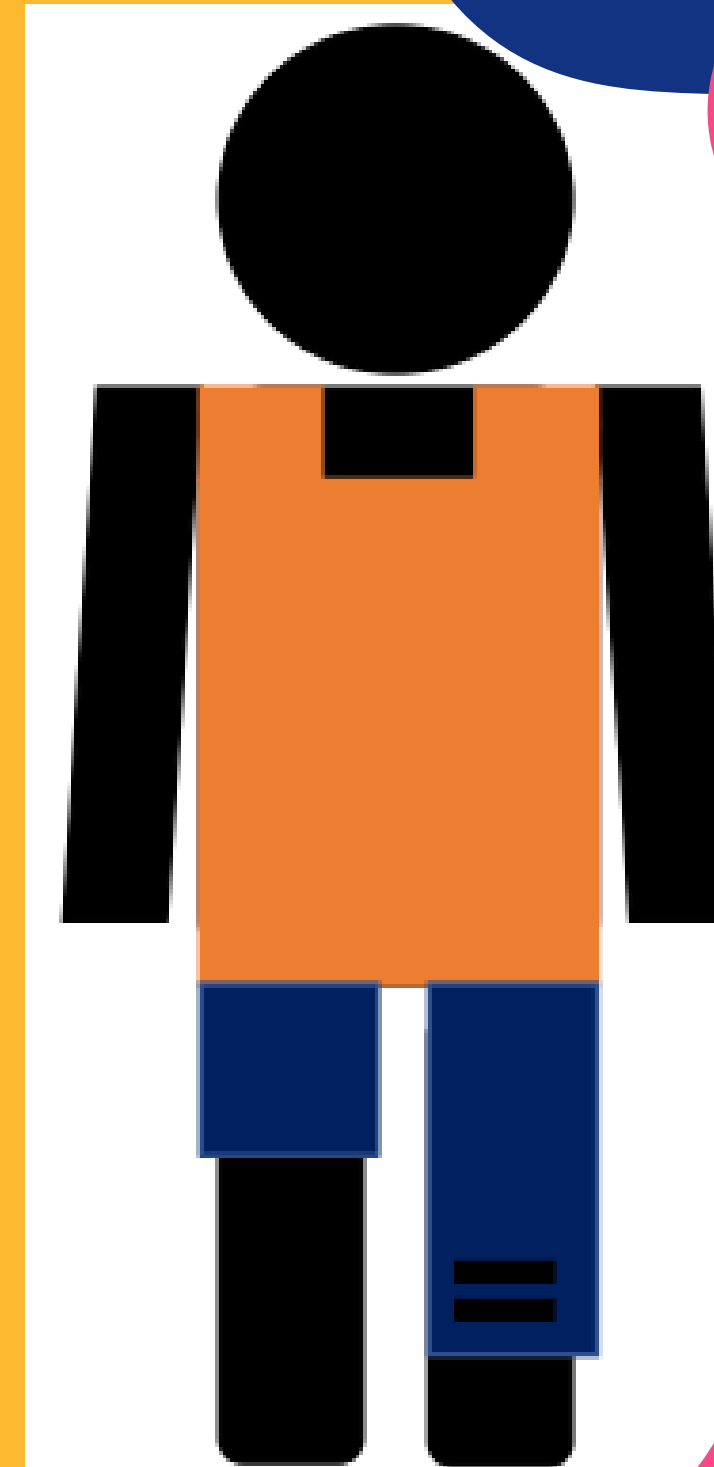
Parents, please be mindful of your attire while in the background of student camera view. All students in the class are able to see & hear you.

EXPECTATIONS:

- Clothes should be worn as they are designed.
- Clothing must cover the body from one armpit across to the other armpit and down to approximately mid-thigh (see image)





Student Participation & Attendance

Student attendance is monitored throughout the day

Early departures FROM SCHOOL for elementary students must be recorded upon each occurrence. This includes when a student logs off for the class or day without contact to their child's teacher.

The day status will be determined based upon time of departure,

- more than half the day would be considered "unexcused absence" until a proper excuse is presented.
- less than half the day would be considered "Early Dismissal Unexcused" until a proper excuse is presented.



Student Participation & Attendance

Student participation is monitored throughout the day

Students are expected to participate in live instruction.

This may be done by camera, typing in the chat, responding to questions or other methods determined by the teacher.

WORK SPACE

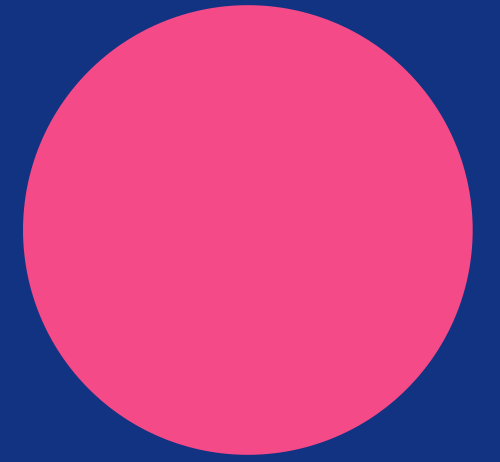
Determine an area that allows the student to focus on learning and work on any materials that the teacher has provided.
